RESPONSIBLE PARENTING

The research is clear: children thrive when they have involved parents-someone who knows and loves them, guides and helps them achieve their destiny. As part of the effort to promote family stability, The Family Center provides a free 12-week program with three focus areas: Parenting, Healthy Relationships and Economic Stability. This program is open to residents of Alabama who have children 18 or younger, or who share a home with a child and any spouse, partner or close relative of the parent. The program is for individuals who want to improve their relationships with their family members, while providing the needed support for their family.

24-7 DAD[©]

A parenting curriculum, which will benefit fathers and mothers who want to parent effectively. It focuses on teaching parents how to work towards being responsible in all aspects of parenting for the benefit of the whole family. 24/7 Dad[©] provides tools to build and maintain healthy relationships with children, parents, family members and the community.

TOGETHER WE CAN[©]

This is a unique, interactive curriculum to help parents learn the skills for creating healthy family relationships. It specifically focuses on the tools needed to learn how to listen better, resolve conflict and be a supportive parenting partner.





Teaching the co-parents how to be more involved in their children's lives through communication and teamwork are the keys for successful relationships.

Economic stability curriculum will offer tools for money management and job readiness. This will include information about furthering education, job interviewing, dressing for success and cultivating the interpersonal skills needed in a work environment. Information about re-instatement of driver's licenses and child care resources will also be provided.

Classes will be taught in our Daphne and Mobile offices, and as arranged with other partnering agencies at their sites. DHR referrals will have top priority for this program and payment of child support will be tracked by our staff. Parents may be court ordered or mandated into this program, but we also accept voluntary participants as space is available. Each class will be at least two hours. Non-compliance to program rules will be immediately reported to the referral source, and may result in termination of services.

All classes are free to the public with funding provided by a grant from the Alabama Department of Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention.
